Art work must include:

3. Date: March 28, 2009

Category:

- Two-Dimensional artwork

2-D pieces must not exceed 22 X 28. Artwork must not be framed.

When submitting your artwork for this contest, Slidell High School reserves the right to decline any piece of art that it deems unacceptable to the general public.

Awards: Presentation and Ribbon

NO Entry Fee: There is a limit of two entries per artist.

Liability – Although the utmost care will be taken in handling the artwork, Slidell High School will not be responsible for damage or loss whatsoever the cause. Sending a work of art to the contest shall imply agreement on the part of the artist to all conditions set forth in this prospectus. We suggest you carry your own insurance if you are concerned about the lack of coverage.

ASSIGNMENT OF INTEREST

In consideration of benefits received and to be received, _____ (hereinafter "the artist") does hereby transfer and assign unto Slidell High School (hereinafter "the school") all of his/her rights, title and interest in and to the artwork submitted by him/her in connection with the Slidell High School 100 Year Celebration Artwork Contest (hereinafter "the artwork").

The artist does further hereby grant to the school (Slidell High School) the absolute and unqualified right to use the artwork, in whole or in part, in whatever manner it may desire, including, but not being limited to, the following:

- A. The right to make or cause to be made adaptations of every kind and character of the artwork, or any part thereof;
- B. The right to change, transpose, add to or subtract from the artwork to such extent as the school in its sole discretion may desire;
- C. The right to use the artist's name as the creator of the artwork; and
- D. The right to obtain copyright upon the artwork and upon any and all adaptations thereof, the right to renew such copyright and the continued right to exercise any and all rights during such copyright renewal period.

The artist declares that he/she is the sole creator and the owner of the artwork, that there has been no publication or any other use of the artwork or any part thereof with his/her knowledge or consent, that he/she has the sole and exclusive right to dispose of each and every right herein granted and that no works have been produced which have been based in whole or in part upon the artwork.
