

Homecoming Dance Dress Guidelines

Theme: Haunted Homecoming

Location: Tennis Courts

Time: 8 pm to 11 pm

Students must arrive by 9 pm. Students will not be allowed into the dance after 9 pm.

What to Bring:

- All attendees should bring their wristband (ticket) & STPSB ID to enter
- \$1 bills if you plan to purchase concessions

Out of School Dates

- Have to be a STPSB student for contact tracing purposes
- Must have school ID and approved completed out of school date form
- Out of school dates must be in good standing and have a clean discipline record

Sober

- If you appear to be under the influence you will be disciplined and your parents will be called to pick you up

Concessions: Please bring \$1 bills if you plan to purchase concessions. We will have pizza, sweets, drinks, and chips

What to Wear:

- Costumes or Semi-formal dress
- All outfits must abide by the STPSB dress code (see below)
- **Costume Limitations:**
 - No weapons (real or fake)
 - No hooded masks (nothing that covers more of your face than a surgical mask)

- Nothing political
- No pointy heels or stilettos. Square heels okay!

STPSB dress code should also be followed

- Natural occurring hair color
- Tank tops and undershirts may not be worn as outer garments
- No see through, sheer skirts or lace-like clothing
- No skin may show in between the lower garment and the shirt in ANY position
- No caps, hats, or bandannas
- No suggestive symbols, words, or advertisements of products or substances
- Lower garments worn by students must be secured at the waist with no undergarments revealed
- The minimum length of dresses, skirts, shorts, etc. must be fingertip length when standing straight up with arms extended down the sides or no more than 5" above the knee
- No hoods or masks that cover more than a surgical mask
- Neatly trimmed mustache, goatee, or beard
- Shirts must be buttoned
