



2017 Enola M. Fee SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

In 1935, when credit unions were helping Americans through the Great Depression, the treasurer of a Midwestern credit union said that credit unions were "not for profit, not for charity, but for service," and that philosophy holds true today. It is a philosophy that as Americans, we should hold true in our everyday lives. The purpose of this scholarship is to introduce our members to the values of cooperatives and the spirit of volunteerism.

As part of GNO FCU's Enola M. Fee Scholarship Award, you are requested to submit an essay. This essay should highlight how you hope to deliver the philosophy -- "**not for profit, not for charity, but for service**" -- throughout your life's journey to your community and country in order to help others achieve their dreams. Exactly what does this philosophy mean to you and how do you plan to use it to assist others?

ELIGIBILITY :

1. Graduating Senior of the 2016-17 School Year or 2017 GED recipient
2. Current grade point average of 2.5 or higher
3. Application and package must be received by GNO FCU by **March 17, 2017**
4. Credit union employees, children of credit union employees, board members and children of board members are NOT eligible to participate.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST:

- Complete application provided by GNO FCU available at all branch locations as well as online at www.gnofcu.com.
- Submit official school transcripts in a sealed envelope from your counselor's office.
- Submit a copy of official ACT/SAT Scores
- Original 250 to 1000 typed essay, doubled spaced on "Not for Profit, not for Charity, but for Service – a Philosophy that Makes a Difference"
- Submit entire package by March 17, 2017 to any branch location or mail to:

AMOUNT OF AWARD: \$1,000.00

APPLICATION DEADLINE: GNO FCU must receive the completed application, transcript, ACT/SAT Scores and essay no later than **March 17, 2017**. All packages are reviewed for compliance with application GNO FCU.

AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIP: Essays are judged on originality, content and grammar quality. Winners are notified by April 21, 2017.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOLARSHIP ACCEPTANCE:

- Must show proof of acceptance and registration at school of higher learning.
- Student must open a Savings Account at GNO to accept the award.
