To Whom It May Concern,

Every year the Louisiana Beta Chapter of Sigma Phi Epsilon Fraternity at Louisiana State University awards three Balanced Man Scholarships. One recipient will receive a \$2,000 award and a second will receive a \$1,000 award. Additionally, the Alumni Leadership Award of \$1,000 will be given to a third applicant.

The criteria for winning the Balanced Man Scholarship focuses on achievement in four categories: Scholar, Leader, Athlete and Gentleman. After we receive completed applications, we begin the process of interviewing each applicant. Following this round of interviews, the applicant may be selected as a semifinalist. Semifinalists and their parents will be invited to join us at our annual BMS BBQ on mid-April. Then, a select group of applicants will be chosen for a final interview with our Scholarship Committee in late June, after which we will select our winners. Subsequently, finalists and their families will be invited to our Balanced Man Scholarship Banquet in June, where we recognize all remaining candidates for their achievements as well as reveal the winners of the three awards. Winners will be young men who have excelled in the four categories of the Balanced Man Ideal throughout high school and who have made a noteworthy impression on chapter brothers throughout our application and interview process. Rewards are granted purely on the basis of living a balanced life along with excellence in any or all of the four categories mentioned above. *Whether or not the applicant intends to join Sigma Phi Epsilon or any other fraternity will not be factored into choosing a winner.*

If any male senior coming to LSU in the fall of 2017 is interested in our scholarship, we ask that they apply through our website, www.lsusigep.com, by clicking on the **Balanced Man Scholarship** tab and selecting the **2017 BMS Application – Apply Now** link in the center of the page. The deadline to apply is **April 1st**. If you could pass this information on to the seniors at your high school, we would greatly appreciate it.
