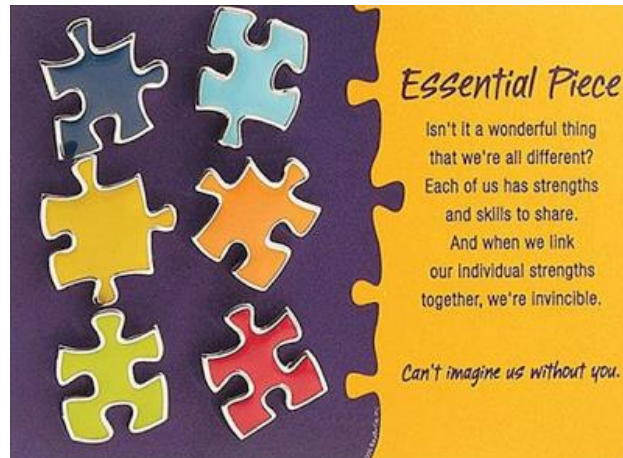


CLASS OF 2017 SENIOR BULLETIN # 6

SCHOLARSHIPS

Please continue to apply for scholarships that have been posted in previous bulletins. All of the applications can be found on the SHS website or in front of Mrs. Francis' office.

- 1) **Henry Powell Memorial Scholarship**- is to be awarded to senior who has a strong desire for higher education and is interested in pursuing a career in a computer-technology related field. The amount of the scholarship will be \$1000 for the recipients first year of college. In order to be eligible, you must have attended SHS for three consecutive semesters, be a resident of St. Tammany, have no suspensions, possess good character, have participated in extracurricular activities, have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA, and have taken at least 2 semesters of computer courses. An application can be picked up in front of Mrs. Francis' office or printed from the SHS website under the counseling link. The application is due April 11th to Mrs. Francis.

- 2) **Jean Chretien Scholarship**- is to be awarded to a female resident of St. Tammany, who has attended SHS since junior year, must be a member of the Swingerettes Dance Team for Junior and Senior Year, and possesses good character and ambitious purpose. An application can be picked up in front of Mrs. Francis' office or printed from the SHS website under the counseling link. The application is due April 11th to Mrs. Francis

- 3) **Hazel George Lansing Memorial Scholarship**- is to be awarded to a resident of St. Tammany, who has attended SHS for 3 consecutive semesters, possesses good character, has a minimum of a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale, and plans to major in education. An application can be picked up in front of Mrs. Francis' office or printed from the SHS website under the counseling link. The application is due April 11th to Mrs. Francis.

- 4) **Ozone Amateur Radio Club Scholarship**- The scholarship is aimed at a graduating senior who intend to pursue further academic studies in the field of Electrical Engineering, Electronics, Communications, Computer Science, the Physical Sciences or related field. The deadline is April 15th. An application can be picked up in front of Mrs. Francis' office and needs to be submitted to the address listed on the application.
