Monday: *There's a storm coming!*

Class Colors

Freshman: White

Sophomores: Grey

Juniors: Black

Seniors: Blue

- Students may wear a top coordinating to their class color along with uniform bottoms
- Alternate: Students may wear their class shirt with uniform bottoms

Example: A Senior may wear a blue shirt and uniform bottoms.

Tuesday: *Twister Tuesday*

Wacky Day

- Students may wear crazy hair, mix and match socks and shoes, and wear a college shirt backward.
- Alternate: Students may wear a college shirt with uniform bottoms.

Example: A student may wear a red knee sock and a yellow sock and two different shoes and their hair in pigtails and their college shirt backward along with their uniform bottoms.

Wednesday: *Which Witch is Which?*

Twin Day

- Students may match tops, accessories, and hairstyles and they must wear their uniform bottoms.
- Alternate: Students may wear a club shirt and uniform bottoms.

Example: Two students may wear the same color top and the same scarf and a high ponytail along with their uniform bottoms.

Thursday: *Lions, Tigers, and Bears Oh My!*

Dress Like an Animal

- Students may wear a top coordinating to the animal they have chosen to dress up as and uniform bottoms. Along with painting their faces to look like the chosen animal. Students may also wear headbands or accessories to match the animal they have chosen.
- Alternate: Students may wear a Camo Shirt with uniform bottoms.

Example: A student choosing to dress like a cat may wear a black shirt with cat ears and paint whiskers on their face.

Friday: *Welcome to Emerald City*

Green Out

- Students may wear anything green along with their uniform bottoms.
- Alternate: Students may wear any Slidell High Spirit shirt with uniform bottoms.

Example: Students may wear green socks, tops, and accessories along with their uniform bottoms.
