To become a certified Election Commissioner you must

- Be a US citizen
- Resident of St. Tammany Parish
- You must also pre-register, attend a certification class, and pass the open book test: <http://www.sttammanyclerk.org/Departments/Elections>

Once certified

- You may be chosen to work as either an Assigned Commissioner or as an Alternate Commissioner on Election Day
- You will be notified, by mail or email, from the Election's team at the Clerk of Court's office

Should a pre-election class be required

- Your attendance and participation will ensure that you are ready to go on Election Day

Work on Election Day will begin at

- 6:30 a.m. for Saturday General Elections
- 5:30 a.m. for Tuesday Federal Elections
- All elections close at 8:00 p.m. or after the last person in line before 8:00 p.m. has voted
